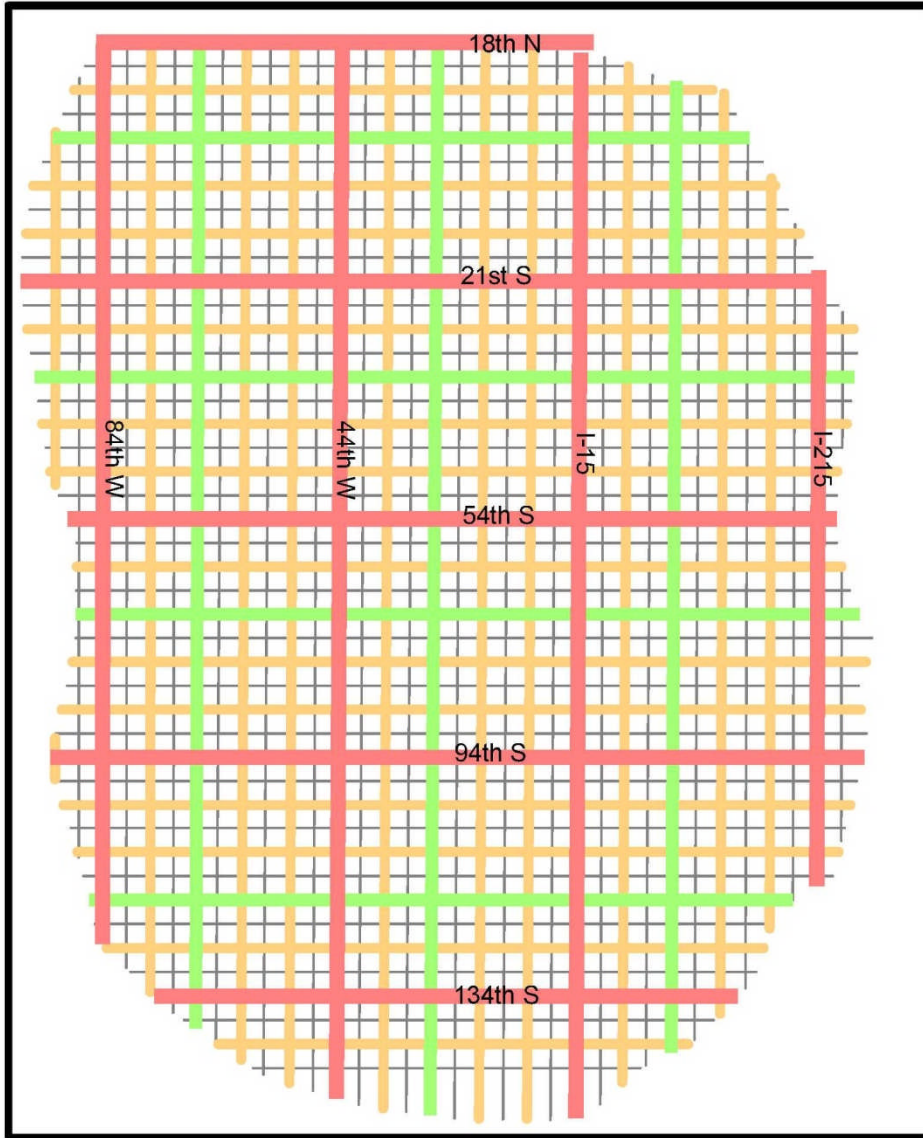


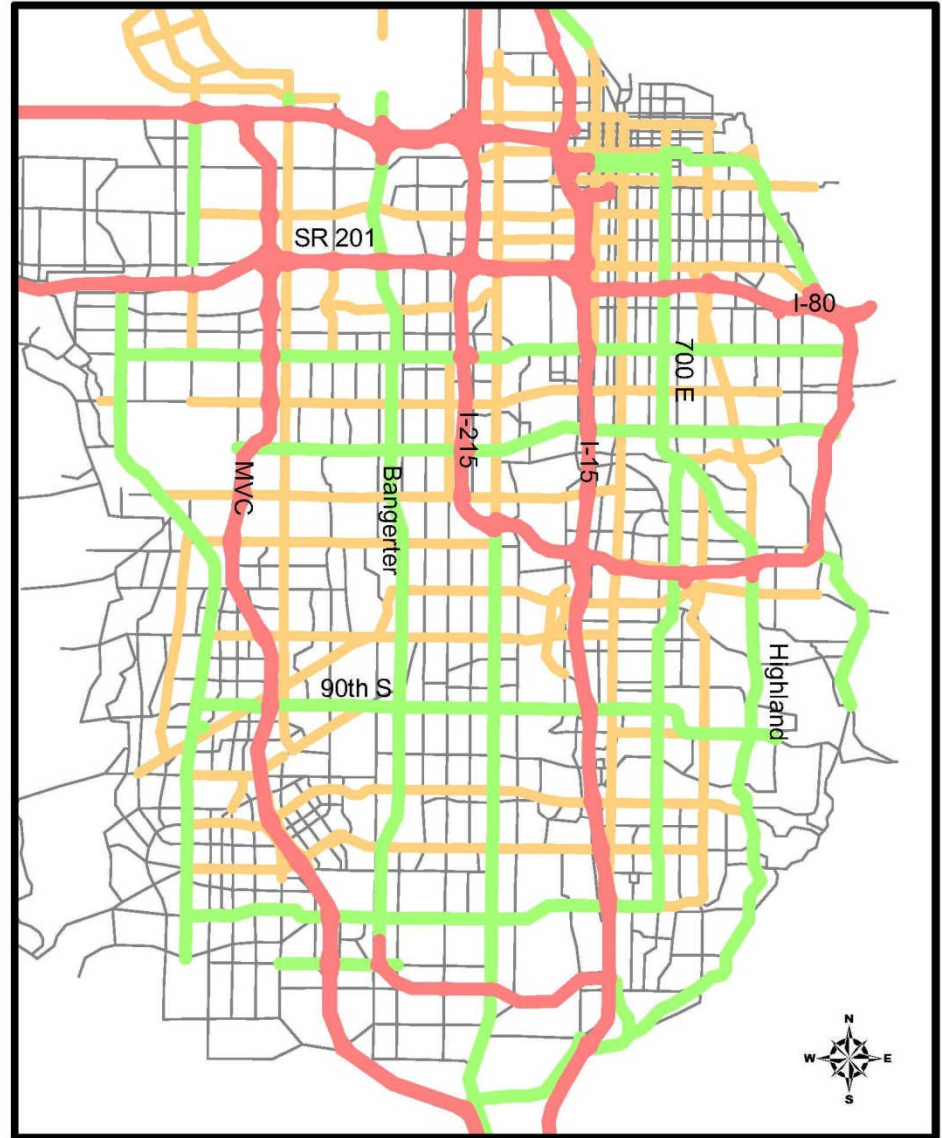
# ITE Ideal Spacing vs. Salt Lake County Actual

\* Institute of Transportation Engineers ideal spacing guidelines: Modest-sized freeway every 5-miles; Principal Arterial every 2-miles; Minor Arterial every 1-mile; Collector every 1/2 mile. This is a rendition of how Salt Lake County might have looked under these guidelines. A close study shows both missing local and regional links – primarily east-west – which creates unique challenges.
